### Keys of the Kingdom Part 1 – Grace

- [Ephesians 2:5](#), King James Version – 5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: 7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
- Grace is letting Christ's perfection rest on you.
- Value grace.
- Grace is undeserved and unmerited. ([John 1:17](#))
- Grace is God's favor, blessing and kindness
- We can all extend grace to others.
- Grace is God choosing to bless us rather than curse us as our sin deserves.
- Grace will show up on "Disobedience Street".
- When you are walking in the grace of God the devil cannot continue to hold you hostage to your past or present.
- It's not about what you did, it's about what Christ has done.
- Rebuke wrong thoughts and be washed in the water of the Word of God.
- If you don't have the death, the burial and the resurrection, you have no substance and no redeeming power.
- Grace is given, but mercy is shown.
