

## Sunday Service Notes from 1-26-20: Pastor Rosa Brown

### End-Times Encouragement.

- Don't let a "word" take you out.
- Don't worry about what people say about you.
- People (especially the religious leaders) talked about Jesus. They called Him a winebibber, a devil and a bastard (They thought His birth was the result of an adulterous relationship instead of the supernatural miraculous virgin-birth prophesied in Isaiah 7:14)
  - **Luke 7:33-35 Holman Christian Standard Bible** - 33 For John the Baptist did not come eating bread or drinking wine, and you say, 'He has a demon!' 34 The Son of Man has come eating and drinking, and you say, 'Look, a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' 35 Yet wisdom is vindicated by all her children."
  - **Isaiah 7:13-14 New King James Version** - 13 Then he said, "Hear now, O house of David! Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will you weary my God also? 14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.
  - **John 8:38-44 New King James Version** - 38 I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father." 39 They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham. 40 But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has told you the truth which I heard from God. Abraham did not do this. 41 You do the deeds of your father." Then they said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one Father—God." 42 Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me. 43 Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word. 44 You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.
- A God-idea is better than a man-idea.
- Renew your mind daily so you can get a new result.
- Be stronger and wiser in 2020.
- There are too many babes in the Body of Christ.
- Work smarter not harder.
- Don't just wish "it" can happen, make "it" happen with Jesus. EXPECT new victory in Jesus.
- Be excited about Jesus—don't magnify your problems. Magnify your Lord.
- Are you ready for Jesus?
- We're going to have a fresh touch, fresh power and a fresh Word.
- Where is your "glow"? Get your joy back. Don't let the devil rob you any more.
- Have love in your heart, not hatred.
- Get rid of unforgiveness and grudges. Get rid of offense.
- We need more love.

- People strive for greed and power, even in God’s house—it should not be so.
- We can all be like the Pharisees, scribes and Sadducees. Read the Word and let it minister to you.
- Find and read the Word for you—not other people.
  - **Luke 6:46-49 New King James Version** - 46 “But why do you call Me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do the things which I say?” 47 Whoever comes to Me, and hears My sayings and does them, I will show you whom he is like: 48 He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock.
- Salvation is free, but it costs to maintain it.
- Don’t take anything God has blessed you with for granted. Praise God all the time—even at home.
- You are responsible for your own salvation. Don’t play the blame game because you have the Holy Spirit.
- You better wake up and stop doing the blame game. Don’t accuse your brothers and sisters in the Lord.
- Keep your eyes on the Lord.
- Don’t base your relationship with the Lord on somebody else.
- People don’t have the power to take you to hell—you do.
- Everything is going down (being shaken) except the Word. Don’t compare yourself with another person.
- Pray for one another and read the Word.
- It’s time to get serious and give our best to the Lord.
- Be sensitive and yield to the Holy Spirit
- The Holy Spirit wants obedience.
- Be in the house of the Lord as much as possible.
- Get a paper Bible and read every day.
- Pray EXTRA for Bishop Brown and for ALL LEADERS (spiritual and secular)
- You only get fed where God places you.
- Don’t church hop.
- No matter what you do, do your work as unto the Lord.
- If you don’t do it for the Lord, it won’t last.
- Go to the pastors and ask what you can do. Then do it with a right attitude. Don’t make excuses.
- Don’t take anything for granted. (Everything belongs to God.)
- All of us need to be more committed and more involved with the things of God.
- Read Matthew 25:1-13 (Ten Virgins—Five Wise and Five Foolish)
- God wants obedience and not sacrifice. In 2020 it should be ALL or nothing.
- What do we deserve when we are disobedient?
- You can be in church for years and not be saved.
- Children pray for your parents in the Lord.
- Teach your children to pray.
- Pray for them to have interest in church and teach them to pray.
- Very few children will play professional sports but all must be ready for God.
- You will be rewarded when you pray for others.
- Strive to be like Jesus.

- We must love everyone even your enemies. You must love one another.
- **John 3:14-15 New King James Version** - 14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death. 15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.
- **Don't be self-righteous.** Be humble ask God to reveal your sin to you.
- **The Holy Bible is not about multiple choice.** You must receive it all as truth.
- **God wants it ALL or nothing.**
  - **Matthew 22:36-38 New King James Version** - 36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" 37 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and great commandment.
- **Children wake up. Obey your parents. Get interested in the things of God.**
- **Proverbs 20:11 New King James Version** - 11 Even a child is known by his deeds, Whether what he does is pure and right.
